

EACR - OECI Lecture: Cancer Systems Biology Barcelona, July 7th - 10th 2012 Systems Approaches to Cancer and Other Diseases Speaker: L. Hood (USA)

Executive Secretary of the OECI have visited the AACI annual meeting in Washington in October 2011. In a meeting with the board and a presentation to their General Assembly by prof van Harten, the OECI activities and recent developments were presented. The conclusion of the meeting was that the AACI and the OECI will start exploring possibilities for cooperation, starting with the exchange of speakers on topics that are of interest to the partners' societies. Furthermore, the AACI has indicated to be willing to cooperate in order to start a project on gathering evidence on the added value of the concept of organisational Cancer Centres. The first speaker exchange will take place during the OECI annual meeting, in cooperation with the Oncology Forum in Berlin in May 2012 with a lecture of Dr Michelle M. Le Beau, PhD, vice-president of the AACI and director of Chicago University.

OECI policy matters; European Union and ECCO

The OECI is adopting a bottom up strategy to implement a structural approach that can offer the best outcomes to cancer patients all over Europe, where, still nowadays, there are many differences between and even within countries. So far equality between Europeans is still a challenge. The impact of the increasing cancer incidence, in general due to the demographic evolution and the living patterns, should be taken into consideration to avoid unnecessary treatments and to be cost effective. The approach of the OECI that consists in solving the problem is mainly related to its Accreditation Programme.

The OECI President and the Executive Secretary have established a contact with the European Commission, Direction General SANCO, in order to support political decisions of the EU that should introduce minimal care levels and make a common legislation, so that also the cross-border care can result in better care when necessary.

In a meeting with the Executive Board of ECCO a more structural cooperation and relationship between the OECI and ECCO was discussed. This could be achieved by having a formal position in the ECCO Policy Committee and by offering development assistance in EU countries that are facing difficulties. A proposal in that sense has been formally presented to the ECCO and we are waiting for future discussions on this topic.

Accreditation and Designation

In 2011 site visits have been organised in Manchester (The Christie), Amsterdam (NKI), Brussels (Institut Jules Bordet) and Helsinki (HUCH). For 2012 the Centres of Oslo (Rikshospitalet-Radiumhospitalet Medical Center), Paris (Institut Curie), Brussels (Free University Brussels), London (Kings Health Partners) and Vilnius (Institute of Oncology, Vilnius University) are taken into the accreditation planning.

Negotiations are being organised with the help of the Italian Association of Cancer Centres to have a joint OECI/Italian Accreditation Programme for Cancer Centres.

Recently it was agreed that the OECI will prepare a proposal for a combined pilot with a German Centre and the Oncocert in Germany. As the administrative burden of accreditation activities in German oncology is already quite heavy, it is to be decided how the additional value of an OECI accreditation, or the additional activities needed to obtain the OECI accreditation, can be realised.

In the EuroCan project we are developing a programme to designate excellence in translational research. OECI members will be involved in a survey on draft criteria and signed metrics later in 2012.



The OECI launched an international collaboration on Total Marrow Irradiation and Total Lymphoid Irradiation in hemopoietic stem cell transplantation. After a first meeting held in Genoa with a restricted number of radiotherapists and experts in nuclear medicine, the decision to pursue a possible European-US project has been taken. The first meeting was kindly supported by the Italian Society of Cancer Radiotherapy "AIRO" and by the OECI. A second meeting took place in Brussels on February 15th at the UZ- VUB Brussel. The encounter defined the feasibility of a study involving haematologists and clinical oncologists. Prof. Guy Storme from the UZ-VUB Brussel and Prof. Renzo Corvò from the Azienda

Ospedaliera Universitaria San Martino - IST of Genoa chair the project.
