

Institut Curie is recruiting a Director for its Hospital Group

1. Institut Curie

Institut Curie is a leading player in the fight against cancer, combining an internationally renowned Research Center and a cutting-edge Hospital Group specialized in the treatment of a wide range of cancers, including their rarest forms. Founded in 1909 by Marie Curie, Institut Curie brings together over 3,300 researchers, physicians and caregivers on three sites (Paris, Saint-Cloud, Orsay) around three missions: research, care, preservation and transfer of knowledge. Institut Curie is a private foundation of public interest.

Today, the modern version of the Curie model based on the care-research continuum is applied in its various aspects through the MC21 corporate plan (Marie Curie in the 21st century). For more information:

2. Main responsibilities of the Director of the Hospital Group

They will supervise all medical and care activities, represent the Hospital Group externally, implement the corporate plan (MC21 – Marie Curie in the 21st century), and play a major role in its medical and medico-scientific chapters. They will implement the medical and medico-scientific policy on the three hospital sites. In order to do this, they will be assisted by deputy directors on each of the three sites, and transversally by heads of department and administrative deputy directors.

They will foster a sense of belonging at Institut Curie on the three sites, promote the global coherence of the "Curie model", be a source of proposals for all issues involving synergies between the three sites and with the Research Center, develop clinical research in collaboration with Unicancer, as well as teaching in collaboration with our academic partners.

They will be responsible for the investment and operating budget, as well as recruitments within the framework of the budget voted by the Board of Directors and receiving any delegations.

They will participate in the work begun on general policy under the impetus of the Board of Directors, supervise budget and medico-economic management, establish the multi-year investment plan and the associated financing plan. They will lead the Hospital Group to guarantee the economic balance and medium- to long-term development within the framework of the multi-year plan agreed upon with the supervising authorities.

In order to implement the medico-scientific project, they will work in close collaboration with the management of the Research Center.

For the construction aspects of the MC21 project, which include €130 million in hospital investments over a period of five years, they will work in close collaboration with the management of support operations.

3. Desired profiles and application conditions

It is preferable that the candidate be a Professor of Medicine with experience at the head of a hospital, and immediately operational. The Director of the Hospital Group is a member of the highest strategic governing bodies of Institut Curie, and sits on the Bureau and the Board of Directors in an advisory capacity under the authority of the President of Institut Curie.

The proposed applications will be examined by the International Scientific Advisory Board and the institute's medical committee, which will give their opinion before decision of the Board of Directors scheduled for June 29. The appointment will be effective for a period of 5 years with no guarantee of renewal. An international call for offers will be published after this 5-year period.
