Two-day International Symposium of Cancer Survivorship care 11 & 12 November 2010, Amsterdam

On 11 & 12 November 2010 the Organisation of European Cancer Institutes (OEI) and the Dutch Association of Cancer Registries (VIKC) will organise a symposium on trends and developments in Survivorship Care in Europe. A symposium that cannot be missed by physiotherapists, social workers, oncology nurses, medical specialists, board members and researchers with interest in recent European developments on cancer survivorship care.

Preliminary Program

Day 1 "Recovery and Balance" Symposium

On 11 November the Dutch Association of Cancer Registries (VIKC) and the consortium working on a national guideline for (physical) cancer rehabilitation organises the symposium. Two international key-speakers will give their vision on cancer survivorship and oncologic rehabilitation. In the afternoon the symposium is meant for a Dutch speaking audience focussing on the draft national guideline.

Day 2 International Symposium: "Trends and Developments in Survivorship Care"

The OEI symposium on cancer survivorship care will be held on the November 12th 2010 for a European audience. We have two recognized keynote speakers on the topic: Prof. Patricia A. Ganz from the David Geffen School of Medicine, Los Angeles, US and Prof. Melinda L. Irwin. from Yale School of Public Health, New Haven, US They will give a presentation on general survivorship care and state of the art of physical rehabilitation in the US. In the afternoon different speakers from various European countries will tell about best practices in their own country. With a panel discussion, chaired by Neil Aaronson, the symposium will be closed. The draft programme content is on the other side.
