- MARIE CURIE ACTION: "INITIAL TRAINING NETWORKS" (ITN)
- Call Reference FP7-PEOPLE-ITN-2008
- Funding Scheme: Support for training and career development of researchers
- <u>DEADLINE</u>: 2 September 2008
- TARGET FELLOWS: early-stage and experienced researchers during the first 5 years (or full-time equivalent) of their research careers
- **DURATION OF EACH FELLOW**: 3-36 months
- **PARTNERS**: OECI; ACC and other networks...

EARLY-STAGE RESEARCHERS,




those IN THE FIRST 4 YEARS
(full-time equivalent)

OF their RESEARCH CAREERS

starting at the date of obtaining the degree which would formally entitle them to embark on a doctorate, either in the country in which the degree was obtained or in the country in which the research training is provided, irrespective ofwhether or not a doctorate is envisaged

EXPERIENCED RESEARCHERS



must, at the time of recruitment

- (i) be in possession of a **DOCTORAL DEGREE**, independently of the time taken to acquire it,
- (ii) or have AT LEAST 4 YEARS of fulltime equivalent Research Experience, including the period of research training, after obtaining the degree which formally allowed them to embark on a doctorate in the country in which the degree/diploma was obtained or in the host country (irrespective of whether or not a doctorate was envisaged)
