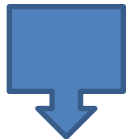

- ❑ To imply patients in the process.





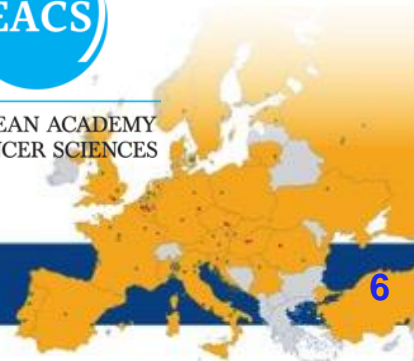

BIG IDEA

- To translate new drugs to earlier stage of cancer
- Early detection of cancers and their relapses in the European population with emphasis in aging
- Early detection of cancer that we don't know how to cure currently (lung, pancreas, brain...)
- Prevention and early detection of cancer
- Preventing and targeting "cancer epidemic"
- To set-up a cancer registry for patients outcomes comparison in a network of 100 cancer centres
- A mission on pediatric cancer
- Quality in cancer care
- Hope in cancer
- Reduce inequities and lift up less well performing regions or countries
- To improve outcomes for all cancer patients in Europe through multidisciplinary

BIG IDEA: true integrative care in cancer

Institutional research of quality from doctors to technicians

No loss of chances anywhere the patients knock on the door

BIG CHALLENGE

Networks around CCCs

To build a European cancer ecosystem

PLAN

To define at least one CCC / Country

To identify one network each 5 to 10 Millions inhabitants



WE NEED TO ADD:

- Rare cancers (including pediatrics?)
- Tumours that are not yet cured
- Early diagnosis of primary tumours and relapses
- Outcomes research
- Governance proposals and financial issues
(more to those who get less today)
- Research on prevention
