




Survey: Mapping best practices in terms of PI and collaborations with Patient

Organisations in OECI centres

81% of OECI cancer centres involve patients in the design of services or the improvement of research.







- May 2018
- Response rate (full members): 87%
 (all members): 78%





Our Proposal for the Mission

1. Ask patients!

- Priorities in cancer research and healthcare should clearly stem from patients' reflections and needs
- The mission proposal should be written with patients!

2. Patient involvement is not a pillar but the cement between the stones

• Each pillar is driven by the patients' needs and calls for specific PI developments and initiatives.
