




Institut Jules Bordet



- Conventions with individuals (not organizations)
 - (collaboration agreements: « mutual engagement, confidentiality, GDPR…)
- 3 years of existence 14 meetings 9 research projects evaluated
 - 8 reports produced 5 trainings* for P&P 3 papers on PISARO -
 - 1 consultancy contract









Evolution of the patient involvement model







Objectives


- 1. Smoother therapeutic pathways and networking to support patients
- 2. Development of professional well-being tools in the healthcare field
- 3. Support for the hospital-city transition and collaboration between 1st and 2nd line care teams
- 4. Recognition and/or integration of non-healthcare professionals to restore the link and the human element in therapeutic relations and the organization of care
- => Local networks allowing for concerted care and support for patients with real teamwork between carers and local resources
- => Ownership by citizens of their cancer journey and well-being



HUMANIZATION OF RELATIONSHIPS

- Inclusion of « non-carers » in care team
- Art/PP/... interventions



HUMANIZATION OF PLACES

- Quality of professional life
- Coaching & Disability Managment

B.CaRe – "The Allies of Care"

- Caring of the carers who take care
- Building interprofesionnal care teams with patientexperts, artists, non-healthcare employees...
- Bringing new resources for patients and healthcare professional
- Developing a culture to support the development of interprofessional collaborative patient-centered care





B.CaRe – "The Allies of Care"

- Phase 1 : Exploration (6 months)
- In practice...
- Questionning dimension of interprofessional care:
 - values and ethics, roles and responsibilities, interprofessional communication, cooperation and teamwork...
- First results:
 - Individual patient support with patient-expert
 - Individual artistic workshops with artist-singer
