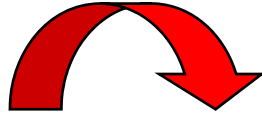

- *Call Reference FP7-PEOPLE-ITN-2008*
- **Funding Scheme:** Support for training and career development of researchers
- **DEADLINE: 2 September 2008**
- **TARGET FELLOWS: early-stage and experienced researchers** during the first 5 years (or full-time equivalent) of their research careers
- **DURATION OF EACH FELLOW: 3-36 months**
- **PARTNERS: OECI; ACC and other networks...**

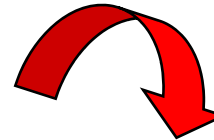

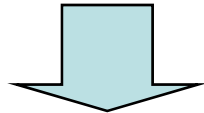

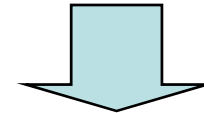
EARLY-STAGE RESEARCHERS,



those **IN THE FIRST 4 YEARS**
(full-time equivalent)
OF their RESEARCH CAREERS

starting at the date of obtaining the degree which would formally entitle them to embark on a doctorate, either in the country in which the degree was obtained or in the country in which the research training is provided, irrespective of whether or not a doctorate is envisaged

EXPERIENCED RESEARCHERS



must, at the time of recruitment

- (i) be in possession of a **DOCTORAL DEGREE**, independently of the time taken to acquire it,
- (ii) or have **AT LEAST 4 YEARS** of full-time equivalent **Research Experience**, including the period of research training, after obtaining the degree which formally allowed them to embark on a doctorate in the country in which the degree/diploma was obtained or in the host country (irrespective of whether or not a doctorate was envisaged)
